Using the University of Vermont campus in Burlington as a base, the week begins with field studies of unique Vermont landscapes. Students integrate many environmental themes including: soils, geology, botany, aquatic biology, hydrology, and water chemistry, and are part of integrative teams that address local environmental issues.
